Dear Judge Engelmayer:

We write on behalf of the Parties in the above-referenced action. We write to respectfully request that the Court adjourn the scheduled Fairness Hearing from March 4, 2022 (see ECF No. 74, ¶ 7) to a date convenient for the Court on or after May 9, 2022.

The Parties seek to adjourn the fairness hearing to a later date to ensure that the Courtappointed Settlement Administrator, A.B. Data, Ltd. (see ECF No. 74, ¶ 5) has sufficient time to implement and complete the Court approved Notice Plan (see ECF No. 74, ¶¶ 12-16) and to provide additional time for absent class members to review the settlement and determine whether they wish to exercise their rights to object to or opt-out of the proposed settlement (see ECF No. 74, ¶¶ 18-24).

In connection with the Motion for Preliminary Approval, Plaintiffs respectfully requested that the Court schedule the Fairness Hearing for a date one hundred fifty (150) calendar days after entry of the Preliminary Approval Order, or at the Court's earliest convenience thereafter. *See* ECF No. 68 at p. 25. As a result, the Parties respectfully request that the Court adjourn the March 4, 2022 Fairness Hearing to a date convenient for the Court on or after May 9, 2022. If the Court adjourns the Fairness Hearing as requested, the remaining dates will be determined based on the dates approved by the Court in the Preliminary Approval Order. *See* ECF No. 74. Counsel for Defendants consent to the requested adjournment. This is the first request for an extension of time in connection with final settlement approval.

For the Court's reference, below are the proposed dates leading up to and after the proposed Fairness Hearing if scheduled on May 9, 2022. The table below includes firm dates based on the Court's entry of the Preliminary Approval Order on December 10, 2021 and the requested adjournment of the Fairness Hearing to May 9, 2022.

¹ We note for the Court that Appendix A to the Preliminary Approval Brief incorrectly indicates that the Fairness Hearing is proposed for "150 days after the Notice Date." *See* ECF No. 68 at App'x A.
